Please remember AND KEEP these few simple rules to make this parade safe and enjoyable for all. They will be strictly enforced.

- 1. All units MUST continue a forward motion at all times. If walkers or your unit stop and delay this parade you will be asked to exit the parade at the closest side street.**
- 2. DO NOT throw anything from your unit.**
This entices small children to run into the street and could cause injury.
- 3. Silly string and water guns are not permitted.**
Silly string is very flammable and dangerous.

The parade lineup will be published in the News Dispatch a few days prior to Saturday's parade. Line up next to your number along Washington St. If you do not see your unit's name listed in the paper, call the contacts below, or check in at 10th St. & Franklin St. after 11:45 AM on parade day.
